# **THE THREE EASY STEPS to Apply**



# Submit a Completed Application

Applications for the incoming freshman class are accepted beginning September 15, 2022. The early acceptance deadline is November 18, 2022. The regular acceptance deadline is January 23, 2023 and the deadline to participate in the lottery is March 1, 2023.

# Take a Math Test and Submit an Essay

Applicants who meets minimum eligibility requirements (see below) will be scheduled for an online math test (beginning late October) and will be asked to submit an essay.



# Participate in a Group Interview

Conducted remotely over video conferencing, the group interview's purpose is to discover more about the applicant's interests and abilities, as well as to allow the applicant to further understand the collaborative nature of IPoly.

# **ADMISSIONS INFORMATION**

#### **Minimum Eligibility Requirements**

Minimum eligibility requirements include a minimum cumulative academic grade point average for the current school year and one year prior of 2.5, acceptable discipline and attendance history, and favorable recommendation forms. Students that transfer in from other high schools must meet the UC A-G course requirements.

#### **Admissions Process**

IPoly has a limited capacity for incoming freshmen. All of the applicants who complete the application process (including meeting eligibility requirements, receiving an acceptable score on the math test, submitting an adequate essay, and successfully completing the group interview), will be considered for admission by an IPoly admissions committee.

# Admissions Timeline for Incoming Freshmen (early/regular acceptance and lottery)

- Application for 2023-24 available on website: September 15, 2022
- Remote entrance exam testing and interviewing begins October 20, 2022
- Application deadline for early acceptance: November 18, 2022
- Early acceptance notifications begin mid-January, 2023
- Application deadline for regular acceptance: January 23, 2023
- Regular acceptance notifications begin mid-March, 2023
- Application deadline for the April lottery: March 1, 2023
- Lottery acceptance notifications begin late April, 2023

Once spaces are full for the incoming freshman class, students may be placed on a waiting list, which will be valid through the next school year.

# **Transfer Students**

Transfer students that are currently in high school may apply year-round and are accepted as openings become available. Eligible students may be admitted to IPoly within the first month of each semester.

#### **Students with Accomodations**

If a student is accepted and he/she is eligible to receive Special Education Services, an IEP meeting will be held with IPoly staff and the student's home district to determine placement and appropriate services needed for student success. If a student is eligible for 504 accommodations, please submit documentation upon acceptance. If the student has an IEP and/or 504 plan and you would like accomodations during the entracne exam, please submit the documents to the office.

#### **Ongoing Report Card Request**

After submitting the application, parents are asked to submit semester report cards as they become available, with the final report card submitted no later than June 30th. This verifies the applicant's GPA is still meeting our minimum requirements.

#### **Final Evaluation**

After a student is accepted, a final evaluation will be completed. IPoly reserves the right to withdraw an offer to any student should significant academic or disciplinary problems arise, whereby the student no longer meets IPoly eligibility requirements.

#### **Enrollment Policy**

IPoly students enroll in college preparatory coursework, commonly known as the A-G course sequence. Every graduate is required to complete the A-G course sequence in order to receive a diploma (LACOE Resolution No. 14:2005-2006). IPoly students who are at risk of not passing the required A-G coursework while enrolled at IPoly may be sent back to their local school district.

#### **Sibling Priority Enrollment**

Siblings of currently enrolled students are given priority status in our admissions process in the case of a waiting list. This is done as a courtesy to families, and to assist in transportation. Siblings must submit completed applications by December 31st, 2021 in order to ensure priority enrollment. Siblings must still meet entrance requirement qualifications and pass the entrance exam.

#### **Nondiscrimination Policy**

IPoly High School is administered by Los Angeles County Office of Education (LACOE), and carefully adheres to LACOE's non-discriminatory policy: LACOE values and respects the diversity of the community it serves. Diversity is an inclusive concept, encompassing race, gender, age, education, sexual orientation, religion, employment tenure, status or rank, national, geographic and language origin, socioeconomic status, and physical ability and/or disability. All individuals involved in LACOE programs and activities are prohibited from discriminating on the basis of any of these diversity characteristics in any LACOE program, activity, facility or contract.
