2018-19 APPLICATION PROCEDURE AND TIMETABLE*

*For Students Attending in the 2018-19 School Year

The instructions and timetable provided below are for your use in completing the International Polytechnic (IPoly) High School application. Please refer to these throughout the application process. Note the following:

I. Campus Visit

A campus visit is essential to understanding the IPoly High School program and requirements. While it is optional, it is highly recommended. If you have not attended a campus information session, please arrange to visit the school. On dates that there are campus information sessions, we also offer shadowing in which a student can spend a day on campus, observing and participating in classes. For event dates, please call 909-839-2331, and select option 2.

2. Submit Application

- a) Applications for the incoming freshman class are released on October 26, 2017 and due by March 9, 2018. Transfer students that are currently in high school may submit applications year-round.
- b) Incoming freshman students, that pass his/her entrance exam, are selected by lottery the week of March 26, 2018. Enrollment is limited to a maximum of 136 students per grade level. Once spaces are filled, eligible students will be placed on a waiting list. The waiting list will carry into the following school year. Transfer students in grades 10-12th are accepted as openings become available (please call for more information). It is recommended that transfer students enroll within the first month of each semester.
- c) Please complete the applicant and parent/guardian portions of the application (forms one and two) and submit remaining forms to school officials for completion (forms three through six: transcript requests, discipline/attendance history, letters of recommendation). Please follow instructions on each form and have the school officials complete and sign all forms, even if they may not apply to the applicant.
- d) Turning in a <u>complete application</u> at one time is preferred over turning in sections of the **application.** Please note that incomplete applications will not be reviewed, however, applicants will receive notification of missing documents.
- e) Complete applications will be reviewed in order of date received. Applicants are not compared against each other, but are accepted on their own merit. Eligible applicants will be invited to take an entrance exam. Exams will be issued monthly, beginning late January.
- f) If the student does not meet our requirements at time of application, we reserve the right to deny or put the student on a hold status until requirements are met. We do take transfer students and encourage students to reapply as needed.

3. Minimum Entrance Requirements

Minimum entrance requirements include a cumulative academic grade point average of 2.5 over the past two years, review of standardized tests, acceptable discipline and attendance history, and favorable letters of recommendation. For incoming freshman, the academic GPA (from math, science, social science and language arts) will be calculated using 7th and 8th grade semester/trimester grades. At the time of the initial submission, 7th grade must be submitted. Students transferring in from other high schools must meet the UC A-G course requirements (to determine eligibility, please submit high school transcripts to IPoly for review). Students that meet the basic criteria will be invited to take an assessment test in math and English, and participate in a group activity or interview conducted on our campus.

4. Math and English Exams

Math and English exams will be scheduled for students who meet minimum eligibility requirements (a letter summarizing test content will be mailed to those eligible). These tests will be for the purpose of further evaluation of student preparedness and will test for basic skills. **Entrance exam test results will be mailed home within four weeks of testing.** Students that pass the exam will be entered into a lottery drawing for final student selection.

5. Group Activity and Interview

The day of the math and English assessment test, students will participate in a group activity or interview. The purpose of the activity is to allow the applicant to further understand the Project-Based Learning aspect of IPoly, and for us to see how willing the student is to work in a team-based setting. The ability and willingness to work in teams is essential. IPoly's Admissions Coordinator, staff, or students may administer the group activity or interview.

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6. Acceptance Notification

Students that pass the entrance exam will be entered into a lottery drawing, scheduled for the week of **March 26**, **2018.** Lottery results will be mailed home.

Due to limited openings, once the first 136 students have been selected via lottery drawing, all spaces will be full for the incoming freshman class. Remaining student names will then be drawn to create a waiting list. Students placed on the waiting list will be contacted once there is an opening; the waiting list will be valid through the next school year.

If a student is accepted and he/she is eligible to receive Special Education Services, an IEP meeting will be held with IPoly staff and the student's home district to determine placement and appropriate services needed for student success before acceptance is finalized. If a student is eligible for 504 accommodations, please submit documentation upon acceptance.

7. Ongoing Report Card Request:

Parents are asked to submit report cards throughout the year, with the final transcript submitted no later than June 30th. This allows us to track the applicants GPA in order to see whether it is still meeting our minimum requirements.

Important: Students must submit 1st semester or 1st trimester report card in order to test, and must submit the transcript in order to have acceptance finalized.

8. Final Evaluation

After a student is accepted, a final evaluation will be completed. IPoly reserves the right to withdraw an offer to any student should significant academic or disciplinary problems arise, whereby the student no longer meets IPoly entrance requirements.

9. Enrollment Policy

IPoly students enroll in college preparatory coursework, commonly known as the A-G course sequence. Every graduate beginning with the class of 2010 is required to complete the A-G course sequence in order to receive a diploma (LACOE Resolution No. 14:2005-2006). Students who are at risk of not passing the required A-G coursework, while enrolled at IPoly, may be returned to his/her local school district.

10. Sibling Priority Enrollment

Siblings of currently enrolled students are given priority status in our admissions process in the case of a waiting list. This is done as a courtesy to families, and to assist in transportation. **Siblings must submit completed applications by December 29 in order to ensure priority enrollment.** Siblings must still meet entrance requirement qualifications and pass the entrance exam.

12. Interdistrict Transfer Requirement for Students Living Outside of Los Angeles County

Accepted students that live outside of Los Angeles County are required to submit an approved Interdistrict Transfer Permit in order to attend IPoly. Parents/guardians must request the permit directly from the School District they belong to once the student is accepted to IPoly. A copy of the approval must be submitted to IPoly no later than registration week in order to attend. A letter will be mailed home to families upon acceptance to IPoly to clarify the process.

13. Nondiscrimination Policy

IPoly High School is administered by Los Angeles County Office of Education (LACOE), and carefully adheres to LACOE's non-discriminatory policy: LACOE values and respects the diversity of the community it serves. Diversity is an inclusive concept, encompassing race, gender, age, education, sexual orientation, religion, employment tenure, status or rank, national, geographic and language origin, socioeconomic status, and physical ability and/or disability. All individuals involved in LACOE programs and activities are prohibited from discriminating on the basis of any of these diversity characteristics in any LACOE program, activity, facility or contract. In all LACOE operations, participants must be especially careful to guard against unconscious discrimination and/or stereotyping. (LACOE Board Policy 7310)

12. Application Assistance

Once received, documents will not be available to the applicant or parent. Please do not submit original report cards or material, as it will not be returned to you.
