CLASS SCHEDULE

ACT PREPARATION

8am to Noon, M-F*

Instr: Joon Park

A comprehensive of review concepts that are frequently tested on the ACT, with a lot of individual practice tests. A customized individual study plan will be set using IXL ACT program, focusing on improving specific areas that will help students to improve their scores fast. Test-taking strategies and time management skills will also be practiced. Class culminates in **ACT test on Saturday, July 17th**. (registration deadline for ACT test is June 18th. To register go to ACT.org. Fee waiver may apply! Check with your counselor.)

DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPHY (5 elective credits)

9am to Noon, M-F

Designed to offer experiences with a point-and-shoot camera. Various camera settings will be learned to offer greater creative and technical control. This course builds the foundation for visual literacy regarding both form and content of photographic images. The elements and principles of design as they relate to photographic composition are emphasized.

GAME DESIGN

9:30am to 12:30pm, M-F

Introduces students to the rapidly developing field of Game Design and production. They will explore current technologies, media and art applications, and emerging technological advances that impact this ever expanding field. They will combine foundations in design, animation, graphic imaging, and multimedia production to develop gaming projects.

GRAPHIC DESIGN

8:30am to 11:30am, M-F

Instr: Joyce Nguyen

Provides students with a foundational understanding of digital design, tools, processes and systems common to careers in graphic arts and digital production. Exploration topics include printing enterprise, art and copy preparation, graphic design, image generation and assembly, production photography, graphic reproduction operations, binding and/or finishing related to digital imaging, printing, and digital production.

MATH BOOT CAMP

Designed to help incoming freshmen students prepare for our accelerated math curriculum, introduce them to IPoly's project-based learning model, and to experience the awesomeness of math! Projects include deciphering of WWII codes and designing a wedding reception.

MODEL UNITED NATIONS

Professional experts in acting, choreography, and singing will direct student actors in staging a musical theater production, culminating in either a large cast production or a showcase.
